INVASIVE SPECIES

- What is an invasive species
 - Ability to grow in many conditions
 - Rapid growth
 - Ability to exploit disturbed ground
 - Ability to thrive in high nutrient environments
 - Reproduce rapidly
 - Ability to survive adverse conditions
 - High photosynthetic rates
 - Lack of natural predators





ECOLOGICAL IMPACTS








- Availability of Water and Nutrients
- Changes light availability
- Toxicity (allelopathic) to other plants
- Disruption to pollination
- Replaces food sources
- Change to natural ecological process
- Genetic dilution

ECONOMIC IMPACTS

- Impacts entire ecosystems
- Reduces productivity
- Causes export and import restrictions
- Reduced property values
- Costs associated with prevention and management
- Impacts recreation and tourism
