The Independent Living Program can help support youth in the following areas:



EDUCATION

High School Diploma/
GED Completion & Post Ed.



LIFE SKILLS

Budgeting, career guidance, nutrition & hygiene, links to community support, and more.



EMPLOYMENT

Career exploration, resume & cover letters, interview support, job training, and more



HOUSING

Emergency housing, short-term housing, and long-term housing.

- WILL MY FAMILY HAVE TO BE INVOLVED WITH CHILDREN AND YOUTH

You do not need to be involved with Children and Youth to be eligible for services. However, some Youth who are referred to IL Services are currently working with Children and Youth.

- CAN YOUTH STILL RESIDE WITH ME AND RECEIVE IL SERVICES?

IL Services can be provided to youth 14-23 regardless of their current living situation.

- HOW MUCH DO SERVICES COST?

They are FREE to you! Services are funded by federal, state, and local means, which are then coordinated through the local Children & Youth Agency.

Budgeting, Daily Living Skills, Career and Educational Planning, Financial Management, Housing Search and Assistance, Job Search and Job Readiness, Mentoring, and so much more!
